

## **RCA Registration Procedure**

[Rowing Canada Aviron \(RCA\)](#) “is a nonprofit organization recognized by the Government of Canada and the Canadian Olympic Committee as the national governing body for the sport of rowing in Canada. RCA represents 15,000 registered members at all levels, novices, juniors, university students, seniors and masters, whether they row for recreation, health and fitness or competition.” Every rower in Ontario who participates in a club activity must register with RCA and RowOntario every year. Registration with RCA includes registration with RowOntario.

**If you already have an RCA account**, please renew your membership by going to the [RCA WRS](#). “Log In”, and “Join a program” under the Barrie Rowing Club. There is nothing to pay there. Association dues are included in your BRC membership/program fees.

**If you are new to rowing**, you will need to open an RCA account as follows:

- ▶ Go to the [RCA WRS](#) and “Create Account Now”
- ▶ Once you have created your account, “Join a program” under the Barrie Rowing Club. There is nothing to pay there. Association dues are included in your BRC membership/program fees.

Please store your login information, as you will need to join a program every year to register as a rower.
